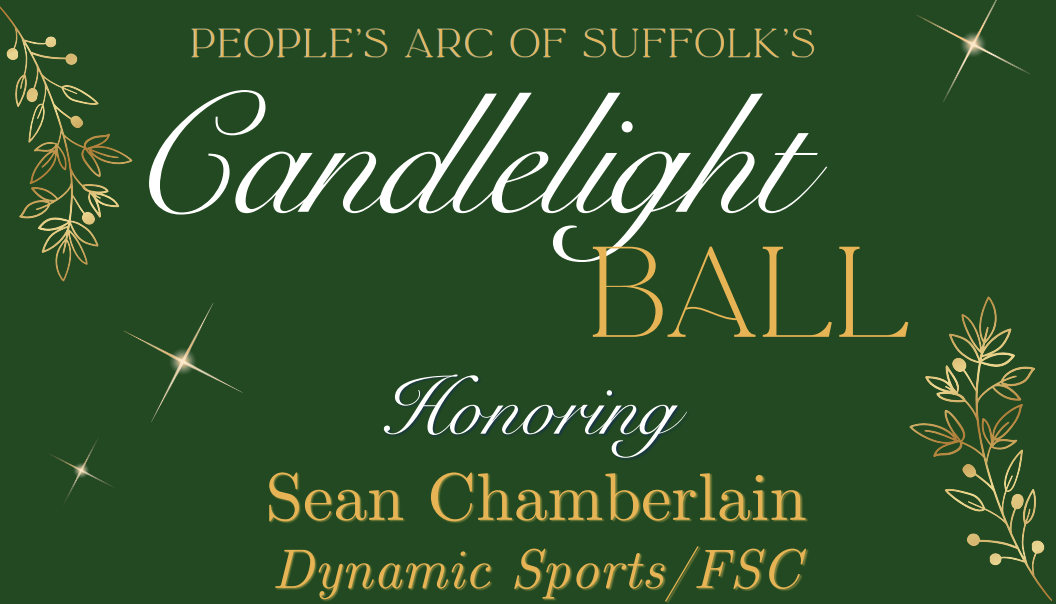

Honoree Sean Chamberlain

Sean Chamberlain is one of the most influential people in lacrosse, both on Long Island and across the nation. He is the Co-President of Dynamic Sports Management, which runs Team 91, Leading Edge, My Lacrosse Tournaments, the National Lacrosse Federation and several more entities. DSM is the country's premier provider of youth club teams, camps, clinics, team events, showcases and leagues. DSM has programs on Long Island and the New York area, as well as many other states and serves more than 10,000 athletes and their families.



Honored as one of Stony Brook University's 40 Under Forty in 2019 and named to the SBU Hall of Fame in 2025, Chamberlain was a four-year member of the Seawolves' lacrosse team. He helped SBU reach the 2005 conference title game and recorded 80 points in his time as a Seawolf. Following graduation, Chamberlain transitioned seamlessly into coaching, taking the helm of the Farmingdale State men's lacrosse program in 2014. Under his leadership, the Rams have reached the Skyline Conference playoffs in all eight seasons, amassing more than 135 wins. A three-time Skyline Coach of the Year, Chamberlain has guided the Rams to back-to-back conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. He has also mentored nine All-Americans and eight Players of the Year.

He has been a tireless advocate for many great causes. Chamberlain continually and proudly promotes and supports the People's Arc of Suffolk, frequently including the Farmingdale State and Team 91 programs in that support.
